***Alcohol Use Elaboration**

Staff members with Campus Crusade for Christ minister to a broad spectrum of the Christian community. To some believers in church leadership and in the mainstream of the body of Christ, drinking alcohol would be considered a questionable activity. Therefore, the leadership of Campus Crusade has put in place an organizational policy that addresses the issue of questionable practices such as drinking alcohol (refer to the questionable areas policy clarification sheet).

On your application you indicated that you occasionally drink alcoholic beverages. While we do not question your liberty in Christ in this area, your use of alcohol does require some elaboration. Therefore, in order to continue processing your materials, it would be helpful for us to have you answer a couple of questions.

1. In what situations do you drink and how often do you use alcohol?

2. When presented with an opportunity to drink, what would cause you to decide it would be appropriate?

3. What would cause you to decide that having a drink would not be appropriate?

Campus Crusade for Christ takes a conservative view on the use of alcohol. Our staff culture is basically one of abstinence. Some evangelical Christians and Campus Crusade staff members have the conviction that taking a drink is always wrong. This means that should you ever decide to take a drink, you need to give serious thought to its consequences and to how it may affect those who may see or even hear about such an occurrence.
